This three year project by Raymond Depardon led him to twelve evolving cities around the world. In each city he lost himself in the crowd, becoming an invisible 'picture thief' to record unguarded images of people in streets, squares, shops, cafes and going about their everyday lives in a series of distinct locations. *"I remained a tourist a little off the beaten track, full of curiosity, but always an amateur"*. Favouring a spontaneous and instinctual approach and shooting pictures on the move, he spent only a short time in each place to ensure that the images preserved his first impressions.

The resulting exhibition of photographs, presented like a continuous filmstrip, captures the movement of people within the metropolis and builds a fascinating narrative exposing aspects of life which can otherwise be taken for granted.

Raymond Depardon began taking photographs in 1954 on his family farm in Garet, France, at the age of 12. In 1966 he co-founded the Gamma photographic agency, reporting from around the world. From 1974 to 1977, as a photographer and filmmaker, he covered the kidnap of French ethnologist François Claustre in northern Chad. He also began to make documentary films alongside his photography career. In 1978, he joined Magnum and continued his reportage work. He has made eighteen feature-length films and published forty-seven books.

Arweiniodd y project tair-blynedd hwn Raymond Depardon i ddeuddeg o ddinasoedd sy'n esblygu ym mhedwar ban y byd. Ym mhob un, ymgolodd yn y dorf, gan fynd yn 'lleidr lluniau' anweledig sy'n cofnodi delweddau diwarchod o bobl mewn strydoedd, sgwariau, siopau, caffis, ac wrthi'n byw eu bywydau bob-dydd mewn cyfres o leoliadau gwahanol. *"Roeddwn yn dal i fod yn dwrist, ychydig oddi ar y llwybr sathredig, yn llawn chwilyfrydedd, ond yn amatur bob amser."* Gan ddefnyddio camerâu elfennol, a heb dalu nemor ddim sylw i athrawiaeth techneg a chyfansoddiad, dim ond amser byr y byddai'n ei dreulio ym mhob man er mwyn sicrhau fod ei ddelweddau'n cadw ei argraffiadau cyntaf.

Mae'r arddangosfa o ffotograffau a ddeilliodd o hyn, a gyflwynir ar ffurf sribed ffilm barhaus, yn dangos symudiad pobl o fewn y ddinas ac yn adeiladu naratif cyfareddol sy'n datgelu agweddau ar fywyd a allai gael eu cymryd yn ganiataol fel arall.

Dechreuodd Raymond Depardon dynnu lluniau ym 1954 ar y fferm deuluol yn Garet, Ffrainc, yn 12 mlwydd oed. Ym 1966, cydsefydlodd asiantaeth ffotograffig Gamma, gan adrodd ar ddigwyddiadau o bedwar ban y byd. O 1974 tan 1977, fel ffotograffydd a gwneuthurydd ffilmau, bu'n dilyn herwgiapiad yr ethnolegydd Ffrengig, François Claustre, yng ngogledd Chad. Dechreuodd wneud ffilmau dogfenol hefyd, ochr yn ochr â'i yrfa ffotograffig. Ym 1978, ymunodd â Magnum a pharau â'i waith newyddiadurol. Mae wedi gwneud deunaw o ffilmau hyd-llawn ac wedi cyhoeddi deugain a saith o lyfrau.

Zed Nelson

Love Me

Love Me reflects on the cultural and commercial forces that drive a global obsession with youth and beauty. Over a period of five years Zed Nelson visited eighteen countries across five continents, reflecting on a world we have created in which there are social, psychological and economic rewards and penalties attached to the way we look.

Whilst Nelson's subjects appear willing participants in an omnipresent culture of bodily improvement, he feels they are also hapless victims – at the mercy of larger social forces and locked into an insatiable craving for approval. As the subject's frailties and pretensions are exposed, so too are we the viewer: our motives for looking, for inspecting, along with uncomfortable reminders of our own vanities and insecurities.

Nelson's seminal project *Gun Nation* was exhibited worldwide, awarded five major international photography prizes and published as a book. *Love Me* was recently shortlisted for the Leica European Publishers Award for Photography. Zed Nelson's previous awards include the Visa d'Or at the International Festival of Photojournalism, France; First Prize in World Press Photo Competition; and the Alfred Eisenstaedt Award, USA. Nelson's work has been exhibited at the National Portrait Gallery, the Tate Britain, and is in the permanent collection of the Victoria & Albert Museum. Nelson has had solo shows in London, Stockholm and New York.

Mae *Love Me* yn myfyrio ar y grymoedd diwylliannol a masnachol sy'n gyrru obsesiwn byd-eang gydag ieuencid a harddwch. Dros gyfnod o bum mlynedd, ymwelodd Zed Nelson â deunaw o wledydd ar bum cyfandir, gan fyfyrto ar y byd rydym wedi ei greu lle mae gwobrau a chosbau cymdeithasol, seicolegol ac economaidd ynghlwm wrth ein hymddangosiad.

Tra bod testunau Nelson yn ymddangos yn ddigon parod i gyfranogi mewn diwylliant hollbresennol o harddu'r corff, teimla hefyd eu bod yn ddiodefwrwr anffodus – ar drugaredd grymoedd cymdeithasol mwy, ac yn gaeth i'w chwant anniwall am gymeradwyaeth. Fel y caiff eu gwendidau a'u ymholiadau eu datgelu, felly hefyd yr eiddom ninnau, y gwylwyr: ein cymhellion dros sylu, dros archwilio, ynghyd â phethau sy'n atgof digon anghysurus o'n balchder a'n hancricwydd ein hunain.

Cafodd project arloesol Nelson, *Gun Nation*, ei arddangos ledled y byd, dyfarnwyd pum gwobr ffotograffig fawr ryngwladol iddo, a chafodd ei gyhoeddi fel llyfr. Cyrhaeddodd *Love Me* restr fer Gwobr Cyhoeddwy Ewrop Leica yn ddiweddar. Mae gwobrau blaenorol Zed Nelson yn cynnwys y Visa d'Or yn yr ŵyl Ffotonewyddiaduraeth Ryngwladol, Ffrainc; Gwobr Gyntaf yng nghystadleuaeth Ffotograffau Gwasg y Byd; a Gwobr Alfred Eisenstaedt, UDA. Cafodd gwaith Nelson ei arddangos yn yr Oriol Bortreadau Genedlaethol a Tate Britain, ac mae yng nghasgliad parhaol Amgueddfa Victoria ac Albert. Mae Nelson wedi cynnal sioeau unigol yn Llundain, Stockholm ac Efrog Newydd.

You will use our digital darkroom to produce your own portfolio, and gain skills and confidence in making, manipulating and archiving your own digital pictures, using your own equipment.

Black and White Photography

Sundays from 19.09.10

This course aims to develop a broad practical knowledge of all aspects of black and white photography and darkroom techniques. The emphasis will be on the creative potential of black and white photography. You will produce a portfolio of black and white enlargements from your negatives, working on a chosen theme.

Landscape Photography

Thursdays from 16.09.10

This course explores images of the landscape within a historical and technical context. For example, we will consider time of day and weather conditions and how they influence the quality of light and evoke changing moods. You will shoot new pictures on location and produce a portfolio of your own images in colour or black and white.

Ffotograffiaeth Ddigidol Uwch

Dyddiau Sul o'r 19.09.10

Bydd y cwrs yma yn eich helpu i ddeall datblygiad cyfryngau newydd mewn ffotograffiaeth a datblygu dealltwriaeth ymarferol eang o Adobe Photoshop, a thechnegau ac offer ffotograffiaeth ddigidol. Byddwch yn defnyddio ein stafell dywyll ddigidol i gynhyrchu'ch portffolio eich hunan, ac yn magu hyder a sgiliau mewn gwneud, adnewid ac archifo eich lluniau digidol, gan ddefnyddio'ch offer eich hun.

Ffotograffiaeth Ddu a Gwyn

Dyddiau Sul o'r 19.09.10

Nod y cwrs yma yw datblygu gwybodaeth ymarferol eang o bob agwedd ar ffotograffiaeth ddu a gwyn a thechnegau stafell dywyll. Bydd y pwyslais ar bosibiliadau creadigol ffotograffiaeth ddu a gwyn. Byddwch yn cynhyrchu portffolio o brintiau mawr du a gwyn o'ch negyddion, gan weithio ar thema ddetol.

Ffotograffiaeth Dirlun

Dyddiau Iau o'r 16.09.10

Mae'r cwrs yma'n archwilio delweddau o'r dirwedd o fewn cyd-destun hanesyddol a thechnegol. Er enghraifft, byddwn yn ystyried yr adeg o'r dydd ac amodau'r tywydd a sut y maent yn dylanwadu ar ansawdd y goleuni a chrewnaws gyfnewidiol. Byddwch yn saethu lluniau newydd ar leoliad ac yn cynhyrchu portffolio o'ch delweddau eich hunan mewn lliw neu ddu a gwyn.

Documentary Photography

Saturdays from 18.09.10

This course will examine the history and practice of documentary photography, focussing on visual narrative and study of the work of photographers in this tradition. Practical techniques are explored and students are invited to research a topic, plan, produce and present a personal photography project, or photo-story.

Photographing People

Tuesdays from 14.09.10

This course explores the factors involved in producing insightful portraits. Through photographing people in a variety of situations and lighting conditions, you will develop an understanding of the subject/photographer relationship. Techniques covered include differential focussing, lighting control, fill-in flash, choice of film and print presentation.

Constructed Images

Tuesdays from 14.09.10

This course will encourage you to experiment with photographic representation using traditional and contemporary techniques including double exposure, pinhole, montage and digital manipulation; create special effects with cameras, in the darkroom and through creative presentation. You will undertake a practical project and produce a portfolio of your own prints using a variety of techniques or concentrating on one in depth.

Ffotograffiaeth Ddogfennol

Dyddiau Sadwrn o'r 18.09.10

Bydd y cwrs yma'n archwilio hanes ac arfer ffotograffiaeth ddogfennol, gan ganolbwyntio ar naratif gweledol ac astudio gwaith ffotograffwyr yn y traddodiad yma. Archwilir technegau ymarferol a gwahoddir myfyrwyr i ymchwilio i bwnc, a chynllunio, cynhyrchu a chyflwyno project ffotograffig personol, neu ffoto-stori.

Tynnu Ffotograffau o Bobl

Dyddiau Mawrth o'r 14.09.10

Mae'r cwrs yma'n archwilio'r ffactorau sydd ynghlwm wrth gynhyrchu portreadau craff. Drwy dynnu ffotograffau o bobl mewn amrywiaeth o sefyllfaoedd ac amodau goleuo, byddwch yn dod i ddeall y berthynas testun/ffotograffydd. Bydd technegau a ddysgir yn cynnwys amrywio'r ffocysu, rheoli goleuo, fflach lenwi, dewis ffilm a chyflwyno printiau.

Delweddau Gwneud

Dyddiau Mawrth o'r 14.09.10

Bydd y cwrs yma'n eich annog i arbrofi gyda chynrychiolaeth ffotograffig gan ddefnyddio technegau traddodiadol a chyfoes, yn cynnwys dinoethi deublyg, twll pin, montage ac adnewid digidol, a chreu effeithiau arbennig gyda chamêrau, yn y stafell dywyll a thrwy gyflwyniad creadigol. Byddwch yn gwneud project ymarferol a chynhyrchu portffolio o'ch printiau gan ddefnyddio amryw o dechnegau neu ganolbwyntio'n fanwl ar un.

Creative Media Cyfryngau Creadigol

Creative Website Design 1

Mondays from 13th September

This course introduces you to basic HTML and WYSIWYG design using Dreamweaver. You will develop an awareness of a range of software packages and applications to produce a user-friendly and functional website, incorporating style sheets (CSS) and multimedia content, and use Photoshop techniques to create your own optimised web graphics.

Creative Website Design 2

Wednesdays from 15th September

This module will expand your web design skills to a professional standard. You will create sophisticated graphics and web-page layouts using Photoshop, expand your knowledge of HTML, and incorporate basic JavaScript, forms, and CSS positioning using Dreamweaver. You will also learn about using Web 2.0 to add interactivity and connections to social networks.

Dylunio Gwefan Creadigol 1

Dyddiau Llun o'r 13eg Medi

Mae'r cwrs yn gyflwyniad i ddylunio HTML a WYSIWYG elfennol gyda Dreamweaver. Creative Website Design 3

Saturdays from 18th May

This final module introduces you to Macromedia Flash MX, the industry standard for creating high-impact websites. You will learn how to create vector graphics and animations, incorporate buttons and interactive elements and add movies and sound to your site. You will use these skills to create a complete interactive Flash web interface.

Introduction to Digital Video

Saturdays from 25th September

A practical course for beginners which introduces you to shooting and editing your own digital video. Learn how to get the best results from your video camera, and discover what makes moving images successful. Undertake a practical project and use Apple Final Cut Pro to produce your own edited sequence.
